

 **BILSI** GENERAL AGENCY AGREEMENT APPOINTING A CUSTOMS BROKER

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT WE:

Do hereby constitute and appoint B I Logistics Services Inc. (“BILSI”) a Customs Broker licensed under the Customs Act, of 4050A Sladeview, Mississauga, Ontario L5L 5Y5 136448396RM0001 (BN) our true and lawful attorney to transact business on our behalf in all matters relating to the import and export of goods, including but not restricted to:

- i) the release of and accounting for goods, document and data preparation, payment of and refund of, all government duties, taxes and levies in respect of imported and exported goods released or to be released;
- ii) the transportation, warehousing and distribution of such goods.

And we do hereby engage the customs broker to perform such services.

AND IN CONNECTION THEREWITH:

- a) to obtain, sign, seal, endorse and deliver for us, all bonds, entries, permits, bills of lading, bills of exchange, declarations, claims and appeals of any nature, or other means of payment or collateral security which comes into its possession and to use the same, including drawbacks and claims of any nature for reimbursement of duties, taxes, levies and the like;
- b) and to receive all such payments and sums of money as are now due or may hereafter become due and payable to us relative to the foregoing; and to endorse on our behalf and as our Attorney and to deposit to and for its own account all such payments.

We acknowledge that any duties, charges or other amounts paid on our behalf or to our account by our Attorney or sub-agent shall be a debt due by us to our Attorney or sub-agent and any refund, rebate or remission of such duties, charges or other amounts shall be the property of our Attorney or sub-agent and we direct and authorize any governmental agencies collecting same to deliver such rebate, refund or remission to our Attorney or sub-agent.

We hereby certify that to the best of our knowledge, all documents and/or information that will be provided to our aforementioned Attorney by ourselves or on our behalf, in connection with this mandate will be true, accurate and complete.

We further hereby grant our Attorney, full power and authority to appoint any other person to whom a license to transact business as a Customs Broker has been issued under the Customs Act as a sub-agent to transact the aforesaid business on its behalf, and to revoke any such appointment and to appoint any other person who holds such a license as a sub-agent in the place of any sub-agent whose appointment has been revoked, as our Attorney shall, from time to time, think fit.

We hereby agree that this Agency Agreement and Power of Attorney and all transactions hereunder shall be governed by the Standard Trading Conditions of the Canadian Society of Customs Brokers which are attached hereto and which have been read by the undersigned.

We hereby ratify and confirm and agree to ratify and confirm all that our said attorney may do by virtue hereof.

This Agency Agreement and Power of Attorney shall be and remain in full force and effect, until due notice of its revocation shall have been given to the aforesaid Attorney, in writing and subject to Article 8 of the Standard Trading Conditions.
